

## Disputed Ownership

There are several items at Train Mountain where Train Mountain and another party are both claiming ownership of the items. Friends and TMRR have compiled a list of items with disputed ownership. We have tried to get pictures of many of the items with disputed ownership.

**1)** Greg Peterson took his trains and trains that he thought were his. Greg is being supportive of the new TM. A few questions have been raised about whether BN3107 which is a Backyard Rail engine and an orange OWYEE RR early SW1500 from Rail Systems are owned by the Petersons or by TM. Since items these were gone before Nov 1, we have no pictures to offer.

**2)** Sharon is also being cooperative in transitioning to the new TM structure. Sharon Breen has claimed that she owns the following equipment. All of it is in the North Bay of the Backshop.

-- The Train Master Engine (Southern Pacific #4812). Listed on the 2007 Train Mountain Engines inventory as belonging to TM.



-- The SeaLand Container Car. Not listed on the 2007 Train Mountain Rolling Stock inventory.



-- 2 yellow flat cars with ends and milled lumber loads. Both are listed as belonging to TM on the 2007 Train Mountain Rolling Stock inventory.



-- 2 UP Box Cars - UP 555119 & UP 960856. Both are listed as belonging to TM on the 2007 Train Mountain Rolling Stock inventory.



-- CSX blue and White SBD 140001 car. Listed as belonging to TM on the 2007 Train Mountain Rolling Stock inventory.



-- Either 133 or 144 engine. Both listed on the 2007 Train Mountain Engines inventory as belonging to TM.



-- 2 NewCastle Coal Cars. All 4 New Castle Coal Cars (391, 482, 585, & 686) are listed as belonging to TM on the 2007 Train Mountain Rolling Stock inventory.



-- 2 Black Tank Cars. Six 4' black tank cars (no lettering or numbers) are listed as belonging to TM on the 2007 Train Mountain Rolling Stock inventory. 3 Cars are in the north bay.



-- UP 24587 Caboose. Listed on the 2007 Train Mountain Engines inventory as belonging to TM.



**3)** Mort & Denny report that their G-gauge display cars are missing. They were on top of the refrigerators in the kitchen. There was a two truck shay, an LGB dockside (Helena) and a custom built steam shovel and tender. There is no dispute of ownership here.... Someone just took them.

**4)** Ross Perrin has submitted the following list of items he claims he owns. The TMRR board and Friends want to settle all these issues with Ross before lifting the Sanction that prevents Ross from rejoining the TM community.

Quentin promised I would have my job as long as I wanted it or was too old to do it with the raise to cover house payments, this made it a clear choice to purchase the property."
